

Dear Friends,

In order for us to reopen the church and assure that everyone is as safe as possible we have developed some guidelines that we, as a board believe are necessary for the wellbeing of all. Please read below to see our recommendations.

First of all, we will provide 2 areas where people may worship. We will have the Sanctuary that will be set up with chairs that are spaced 6 feet apart to comply with State mandates of social distancing.

Second, we will have the Fellowship Hall set up with chairs set 6 feet apart as well for those who may be fearful of a large group setting because of a compromised immune system. You will be able to see the computer presentation and hear the service. We are working on providing video as well but that may not be available right away.

If you don't feel comfortable attending in person at this time, or you don't feel well, the messages will still be available online.

With that being said, here are the steps that we believe are necessary to keep everyone safe as well as enjoy Worship services together.

1. Before entering the building, we recommend that you wear a face mask. Please feel free to take advantage of the hand sanitizers that will be available throughout the building or wear gloves if you wish.
2. We may have someone taking your temperature with an infrared thermometer as you enter to make sure no one has a fever. We would hope that you would stay home if you are sick, but you may not realize it and have a fever.
3. We will have Ushers at the door to direct you into the church, one at a time or in family groups. They will direct you to the Sanctuary or Fellowship Hall as you prefer. The directional flow will be one way in and one way out. Enter thru main door and proceed to the Sanctuary or Fellowship Hall. Exit through the door leading to the garden if you are in the Sanctuary. If you are in the Fellowship Hall, you will be directed out the exit door in that room.
4. We would recommend face masks be worn at all times.
5. Please remain 6 feet apart and refrain from physical contact unless you are of the same family.

6. At the end of the service the Ushers will direct you out the appropriate exit. We will not exit through the main entryway. We will use the side doors.
7. Please do not congregate in any groups either inside or outside of the building.
8. There will not be Bibles or hymnals out for the time being. The Bible verses and words for music will be on the screens and TV.
9. There won't be any Sunday School/Nursery or coffee offered at this time.
10. We will start at 10:30 am as usual.
11. An accurate record of who is in attendance will be taken in case of an outbreak among Church attendees.

Please remember \*\*\*Special arrangements have been made to accommodate those with compromised health conditions. The Fellowship Hall will be set up with social distancing of 6 feet and the TV will have the message and music on it. Directional flow will be in the main entrance and out the exit door of the Fellowship Hall.

\*\*\*Cleaning and disinfecting will be done after every service in the following manner. We will close the building immediately following the service on Sunday. On Wednesday morning the chairs will be sprayed with disinfectant and allowed to set over night. Thursday we will do a thorough cleaning of all touchable surfaces with disinfectant. Anyone wishing to help on Thursdays, we will be cleaning from 10 am - 12 noon.
